THE FOLLOWING POLICY APPLIES TO ALL STUDENTS TRANSFERRING INTO ST. JOHN VIANNEY SCHOOL

Students in grades 3-8 who transfer to St. John Vianney School will be admitted on a probationary status. After a six (6) week period, the principal will meet with any teacher(s) necessary. At that point, the principal will take one of the courses of action listed below. The course of action taken by the principal and its reasoning will be conveyed to the parents by way of letter.

1. The student has met the expectations for standards of behavior and academics and has been removed from probation status.
2. The student has met partial expectations for behavior and academics, but has not met the standard expectations. Therefore, the student will continue to be on probation for an additional four weeks. At that time the student's behavior and academic performance will again be reviewed by the principal.
3. The student has not met the academic or behavior expectations. Therefore, the student must be withdrawn from school.
